Students will be guided through several drawing experiences to develop perceptual skills and “look” at the world around them, learning to recognize, depict, and draw what they see and what they imagine. Students will identify and practice basic principles of art: line, shape, color, texture, value, and space. Projects will include using charcoal, oil pastels, and colored pencils.

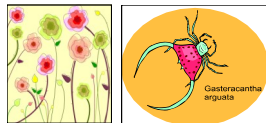
