   For high relief, 75 lbs. is recommended.
- 25 lbs. of porcelain clay. Toki Porcelain is first recommendation followed by Babu or Yoi.

# Underglazes/Glazes

- Assorted underglazes or engobes of your choice, ¼ pint size: black, white, blue, pink, yellow, green, such as Amaco Velvet, Spectrum, Mayco, Western, Laguna, Leslie's U-Series underglazes, or Leslie's Happy Engobes.
- A minimum of 3 glaze stains of your choice,
   ½ lb. each: pink, blue, turquoise, yellow,
   brown, black, green, teal.


